### **FEES**

Or drop off form at the McDowell Senior Center on 100 Spaulding Road by 4:00pm. **Final Registration deadline is Thursday, April 15th and the registration fee is \$8.00 per person.** This year's fee includes T-shirt, goody bag, and entry fee to the "Follies Talent Show" on Thursday, April 30th at the McDowell Senior Center. This **does not** include the awards banquet meal on Thursday, May 20th. You must purchase a ticket for this event and you may invite guests to the dinner. **TICKETS ARE \$5.00 A PERSON.** Everyone must prepay \$5.00 by, Monday, May 3rd. Please complete the senior games awards banquet form enclosed in this registration form.

### **GOLF**

To qualify for State Finals, golfers need to meet a minimum performance score (MPS) **and** finish in the top 3 in their age group. The minimum performance standards are as follows:

### **TRANSPORTATION NEEDS**

If you do not drive and need transportation to any senior games event or senior games special event then please let me know in advance so special arrangements can be made with the van drivers at McDowell Senior Center. See the **Senior Games Coordinator to make arrangements.**

## ELIGIBILITY FOR MCDOWELL COUNTY SENIOR GAMES:

1. A person must be 55 years of age or older to participate. A participant's age on December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year determines the age category in which they will compete. Local senior games will have the responsibility for determining the age classification. Proof of age may be required at registration.
2. A participant must be a N.C. resident for a minimum of three consecutive months of the year.
3. There is a registration fee, which entitles participants to enter the sports or SilverArts events of their choice.
4. A participant may not duplicate any one event in two different age groups.
5. McDowell County Senior Games is for McDowell County residents and participants from outside the county may register upon approval of McDowell Senior Games Steering Committee. Participants who want to register need to call McDowell Senior Center and give a written request to the senior games coordinator. (Participants need to write down why they need to participate in McDowell Senior Games, what event, along with their name, address and phone number and the steering committee will vote on it.

In every event, the safety of each participant and sportsmanlike conduct is of paramount concern. Event managers have the responsibility and authority to disqualify any participant and/or spectator when circumstances warrant.

All appeals for official interpretations shall be made to the Events Director, Sue Huskins.

All appeals must be filed immediately or right to appeal will be forfeited.

It is **your** responsibility to check with your local games coordinator to determine if you qualified for state finals and to get a state finals entry packet. The State Finals Entry Form must be received by 5:00p.m. on **August 1, 2010.**
